JEONG AWARDS from the University of Malaga, for the best Bachelor´s Thesis and Master´s Thesis in “Inclusion, marginality and equality in Korea”

**2024 Call**

Bases

Preamble:

The AKS-2021-INC-2250002 project, called “Path to Equality: Korean Studies Network on inclusiveness” is a project of the East Asian Studies Area – Department of Historical Sciences of the University of Malaga funded by the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Korea through the Academy of Korean Studies (AKS). The objective of this project includes the creation and study of lines of research within the framework of equality and inclusion in Korea.

**Article 1. Object**

- 1.1. The AKS-2021-INC-2250002 Project (hereinafter, AKS) announces an award aimed at the students of any Spanish, of the German universities of Tübingen and Goethe, and the University for Foreigners of Siena in Italy with a Bachelor's or Master's Degree Final Project in any academic discipline that is oriented to the thematic lines indicated in section 1.3. The same must have been completed and defended between January and December 2023.
- 1.2 This award is aimed at the best Final Degree Projects/Master's Final Projects (hereinafter, TFG/TFM) and is a type of award of great interest to the undergraduate and master's degree students, as it promotes the recognition of those students. who have stood out for the quality of their work in the different lines of research: equality, inclusion, marginalized groups, social movements, gender perspective and liberation of social groups in Korea.
- 1.3 The objective of this award is to encourage the completion of work that investigates and disseminates issues of equality, marginality and inclusion in Korea.



## **Article 2. Endowment of prizes and categories**

2.1 A prize is awarded with a sum of 750 euros divided between the two categories and a Diploma of Accreditation:

- Award for the best Final Degree's Project: 350 euros.
- Award for the best Master's Thesis: 400 euros.

2.2 The prizes will be personal and non-transferable and will be subject to the corresponding tax withholdings in accordance with current legislation. Under no circumstances may they be subject to change, alteration, or other type of compensation.

2.3 In the event that the jury considers that the works are not of sufficient quality or that **there is not the minimum number of students submitted to the call**, the prizes may be declared void.

## **Article 3. Requirements of participants**

3.1 Students who have defended their Final Degree's Project or Master's Thesis between January and December 2023 in any of the degrees taught at the different university centers in Spain, of the German universities of Tübingen and Goethe, and the University for Foreigners of Siena in Italy may participate in this call.

3.2 Only the Final Degree's Project or Master's Project completed on the themes indicated in section 1.3, and who have obtained a minimum final grade of 8 (remarkable) will be eligible.

3.3 Participation in this call is compatible, at least as far as it is concerned, with any other award, scholarship or aid received by applicants for completing the Final Degree's Project or the Master's Thesis with which they are competing.

## **Article 4. Documentation and application deadline**

4.1 The application for participation in this call will be submitted using the form available on the website from the East Asian Studies Area of the University of Malaga, Research Projects / AKS / Activities section:

4.2 Those interested in participating in the call should submit their application in a single file, either in PDF format or compressed file with .zip or .rar extension (maximum size 10 MB), the following documentation and in the same order in which it is listed below:

- a. Application for participation in the call form completely completed.
- b. Copy of the author's ID/Passport.
- c. Certificate issued at the secretariat of the corresponding Center stating the author and title of the TFG/TFM, as well as the date of its defense and qualification obtained.
- d. Cover letter highlighting the reasons why the work should be awarded.
- e. Letter signed by the tutor of the work where approval is shown regarding the presentation of the award.
- f. A summary of the work with a maximum length of 1,000 words that contains, at least the objectives of the work, the methodology and the conclusions.
- g. Copy of the TFG/TFM in PDF format.

4.3 The compendium file of all the required documentation will be sent to the following email address: [asiaoriental@uma.es](mailto:asiaoriental@uma.es). Any application that fails to comply with this assumption will not be evaluated. The JEONG AWARDS + initials of the contestant must be indicated in the subject of the candidacy message (e.g. If the contestant's name is Paula García López, indicate JEONG AWARDS + PGL).

4.4 The deadline for submitting the application for participation and the required documentation begins on the same day this call is published on the East Asian Studies Area website and will end on May 31, 2024 at 11:59 p.m. Any change in the deadline for submitting documentation will be communicated on the same website.

4.5 Applicants will receive confirmation of the acceptance of their application by email.

4.6 Non-compliance with the applicants' requirements, lack of required documentation and/or late submission will be grounds for exclusion from the call.

## **Article 5. Work characteristics**

5.1 The works must be written in Spanish or English and must be original.

5.2 The works must have been defended and approved between January and December 2023.

5.3 The tutor of the Bachelor's or Master's Final Project must endorse its submission to the competition.



## Article 6. Jury

The Jury will be composed of:

- Prof. Antonio J. Doménech, Professor of the East Asian Studies Area of the University of Malaga and Principal Investigator of the project AKS-2021-INC-2250002.
- Prof. Eun Kyung Kang, Professor of the East Asian Studies Area at the University of Malaga.
- Ms. Patricia Chica, Professor of the East Asian Studies Area at the University of Malaga.

6.1 The position of president of the Jury will be held by the principal investigator of the project AKS-2021-INC-2250002.

6.2 The position of secretary of the Jury will be held by one of the professors from the University of Malaga.

6.3 All members of the Jury will participate with voice and vote.

6.4 The member of the Jury who has participated as tutor/co-tutor in any of the works submitted to the call must abstain from evaluating said work.

## Article 7. Ruling

7.1 The Jury's decision will assess the originality of the work, the methodology, the quality and relevance of its results, and its possible theoretical and practical implications.

7.2 The ruling will be adopted by consensus of the members of the Jury and, if this is not possible, by a simple majority of favorable votes.

7.3 The ruling will be final and cannot be appealed by the participants.

7.4 The Jury may declare none or all of the award's void if it considers that the works presented do not reach sufficient quality or if **there is no minimum number of students submitted to the call.**

7.5 Any issue not expressly provided for in the bases of this call will be resolved by the Jury.



## **Article 8. Publication of the ruling and delivery of the prizes**

- 8.1 For the purposes of communication and dissemination of the awarding of the prizes, the decision will be made public before December 31, 2024, through the website of the East Asian Studies Area of the University of Malaga and will be communicated to the winners by email.
- 8.2 The awards will be presented at a public event convened for this purpose, the date, place and method of which will be announced in advance. The amount of the prizes will be credited to the winners after said event.
- 8.3 The participation of the person awarded at the awards ceremony will be required to claim the prize, being this participation possible both online or in person. In order to publicize the most relevant and innovative aspects contributed, each of the award-winners will make a brief presentation of their work at said event, in accordance with the time allocated by its organization.
- 8.4 The person who wins the prize authorizes the East Asian Studies Area to disseminate the Jury's ruling on their website, social networks, newsletters or any other means of communication, including the name and basic information of their work (title, summary, keywords, degree and course).
- 8.5 The contestants authorize to the East Asian Studies Area to publish on its website, social networks, information bulletins or any other means of communication, the images, audios and videos in which the contestants themselves appear during the events linked to this call.

## **Article 9. Protection of personal data**

- 9.1 The participants in the call are informed that their personal data to which the University has access as a consequence of their attendance, are incorporated into the corresponding file of the University, authorizing the latter to process the data that is necessary for its use in relation to the development of the call and that will be mandatory.
- 9.2 Participants are informed of their right to opposition, access, rectification, and cancellation of their personal data in the terms provided and in accordance with current legislation, and may exercise these rights, at any time, in writing accompanied by a copy of the Document. National Identity and addressed to the University of Malaga, East Asian Studies Area, or by means of an electronic document with a signature with a digital certificate addressed to the electronic address of the area.



## **Article 10. Final provisions**

- 10.1 Situations not provided for in these bases, as well as all clarifications and interpretations thereof, will be resolved by the Jury.
- 10.2 All references for which the generic masculine form is used in this call must be understood to apply equally to women and men.
- 10.3 The presentation of the application implies acceptance of the content of the bases of this call.
